**Brief Description:**

The exhibition “War of Extermination. Crimes of the German Wehrmacht 1941 – 1944” was touring from 1995 up to 1999 through 33 German and Austrian cities and had approx. 800,000 visitors.

After diverse discussions and constructive criticism the exhibition was totally overhauled and started 2001 as a new one under the name “Crimes of the German Wehrmacht. Dimensions of the War of Extermination 1941 – 1944” in Berlin. Up to 2004 more than 420,000 visitors have seen the exhibition on 13 sites.

Wenzel Consulting was asked to find a permanent site for the exhibition which needs a surface of about 1,000 sqm. For two selected sites we carried out site evaluations and visitor prognoses.

In the end it was decided not to install the exhibition on a permanent site. Meanwhile it is stocked in the depot of the German Historical Institut.
