#### Brief Description:

Sports Park Wedau is the largest coherent complex of sports and leisure facilities in North Rhine-Westphalia. It offers numerous possibilities for activities primarily in the segment of water sports. MSV-Arena and the world famous Duisburg Regatta Course are located there.

New plannings for the re-development of Sports Park Wedau provide an artificial canoe slalom/whitewater track which meets all requirements of the International



Canoe Federation. The track shall complement the facility in the segment trend sports and support the city's competence in water(sports).

The cooperation Herbstreit/Wenzel Consulting was tasked to examine this project whereby Herbstreit analyzed the plannings and Wenzel Consulting the economic feasibility.
